LEAVE OF ABSENCE AND TERM DATES

The School Regulations relating to absence during term time and in so far as they relate to holidays is given below for guidance:-

In view of the extensive nature of school vacations, leave of absence will not be granted to permit an early start, to avoid possible traffic congestion or for any other reason which would undoubtedly apply to other pupils and their families and to the teaching staff, who are expected to fulfil their duties and responsibilities as defined by the dates of terms and holidays.

Leave of absence is normally granted on written request to the *Principal* with at least two weeks notice in the following circumstances:-

- (i) In order that a pupil may attend unique and important family occasions.
- (ii) In order to join his/her family on the annual family holiday where this must be taken during school term time, either wholly or in part, as dictated by the conditions of parental occupation in which parents have no choice in the matter and subject to the pupil not enjoying another extensive holiday at another time of the year.
- (iii) Unavoidable travel circumstances e.g. late notification of flight times.

(Special arrangements apply to children under statutory school age. Please contact the Vice-Principal (Infants) for details.)

If permission is not sought, or is requested at too late a stage, the absence will be classified as unauthorized in documentation that the school is legally obliged to submit to the DfE.
